THE WILTSHIRE COUNCIL RAMSBURY 9A and 9B (part) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

This order is made by Wiltshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the Marlborough and Ramsbury Rural District Council area dated 1952 as modified under the provisions of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in section 53(3)(c)(ii) & (iii) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows –

- (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description;
- (iii) that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which this order relates.

The Wiltshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 06 December 2024
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the Marlborough and Ramsbury Rural District Council area dated 1952 as modified under the provisions of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 shall be modified as described in Parts I and II of the Schedule and shown on the plan attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Wiltshire Council Ramsbury 9A and 9B (part) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2024
